

**Crash Survivor and Traffic Safety Heroism
Nomination Award**

Each year, your agency responds to and investigates traffic crashes. These crashes involve numerous injuries and unfortunate fatalities. If your agency would like to nominate and award a citizen for preventing an injury or fatality by taking that extra precaution of wearing their safety belt, using a child safety seat, wearing a bicycle or motorcycle helmet, or assisting at a crash site, you can nominate that individual to receive a special recognition from your department through the Wisconsin Information Network for Safety (WINS) and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's Bureau of Transportation Safety.

Indicate the recognition award category, and if available, forward a copy of your accident report and photos. All nominees will be awarded a Survivor Appreciation Certificate or a Traffic Safety Heroism Certificate on behalf of your agency, from WINS. All nominations will be evaluated for the **Survivor of the Year Award**, which will be presented to the recipient by your department during the Wisconsin Governor's Conference on Highway Safety.
