The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) created a standardized course to teach concerned adults how to help caregivers do a better job of protecting children and reducing the number one killer of children, motor vehicle crashes. Upon completion of the training, participants are certified entry level technicians that can serve as a community resource educating others in child passenger safety. Through a grant from WI~DOT scholarships are available for the certification training. *Applications for a scholarship must be received 3 weeks prior to the start of the class.*
